BURRUMBEEP SUCCESSION PLAN 2008

The Club Committee has agreed to adopt the following succession plan to manage the smooth transition of memberships to the younger generation at reduced cost.

The basis of this plan is to enhance the current procedures to keep the younger generation connected to the club, and in time to provide a smooth path for them to become more involved in managing the club within a Family Group structure. At the same time it allows the parents to take a less active but 'still connected' position with the Club.

The first step is to encourage the younger generation, who are no longer child debenture holders, to purchase an Associate Membership. (Cost is \$750 which is equivalent to 25 night's accommodation at the current differential between member and guest rates)

The second step is to create the position of **The Family Group** within the Club.

The Family Group will include any, or all, of the following categories:

- Member
- Spouse Debenture
- Child Debentures (ceases at age 25 or when full time study ceases whichever comes first)
- Associate Member (usually an ex-child member)
- SAM (Senior Associate Member)

A Senior Associate Member will be created when a Member transfers their Membership to one of their children who hold an Associate Membership. The SAM will include both the Original Member and Spouse/Partner (former debenture holder).

This transfer will be at no cost.

Under this new arrangement any other Child Debentures and/or Associate Memberships held within The Family Group will continue uninterrupted.

All categories of The Family Group listed above will enjoy the reduced accommodation rates charged by the club.

Maintenance levies will be payable by the Member only.

This arrangement will not prevent a second adult child within a Family Group from buying a Full Membership if they so desire.

Any Full Member can stand for election to the Management Committee
