

BURRUMBEEP NEWSLETTER



The Extraordinary Meeting held at Ballarat on 27th May, 1994 to discuss the concept of Associate Memberships was attended by twelve members and after a few hours of quality discussion the following motion was passed.

You will see that some 'companion' decisions in respect of membership transfers and debentures were also decided upon.

'That the position of Associate Member be created to encourage and extend the interest of Members' children in Burrumbeep once their Debentures cease at the age of 21 years.

Offer:

That the Associate Membership be offered to those Members' children who attain the age of 21 years and who had previously held a Debenture. The offer will only be made once.

Cost:

The cost shall be \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) (and may be varied at an Annual General Meeting).

Acceptance:

The offer must be accepted within twelve months with the payment of at least fifty percent of the fee, with the balance (if any) on the first anniversary of the acceptance.

Refund:

The Associate Membership fee will not be refundable except for compassionate grounds at the discretion of the Committee.

Rights:

An Associate Member will have the same rights as Debenture-holders.

Obligation:

An Associate Member will be required to attend work parties or pay the maintenance levy.

The Associate Membership will be attached to a membership in the same way as Debentures. Both attachments will cease on the sale or transfer of the membership.

If a Member dies and the membership transfers to the spouse, both the Associate Membership and child Debentures can continue.

Debentures:

All existing and future debenture fees will not be refundable after 30th June, 1995:

Bookings:
